Position Chart for the Tenor Trombone

This chart shows the positions for the tenor trombone with F-attachment. The first measure shows the pedal tones which are the lowest notes possible, with the notes in 4th through 7th positions being extremely difficult. From the second measure to the stepped bracket are notes in the primary positions, meaning the positions where one normally learns to play these notes. Those notes to the right of the bracket are in what are called alternate positions. The designation of primary or alternate does not necessarily mean that one position is better than the other as you shall learn as you progress through this book. Embellishment spellings are included on both charts.

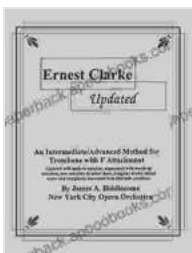
Positions on the F-attachment are altered from the standard 7 positions. First, due to the extended length of the horn there are now only 6 positions. Because C natural second space is an important note, I want C to be in tune in 1st position with the valve, therefore F below the first line is first. You may "lo" that note in tune as, if you have springs in the lead, you may pull as, even then you may still have to "up" some to get F in tune. The notes are played as shown below with the upper notes being common alternate to regular positions without the F-attachment.

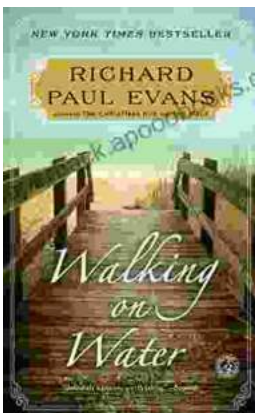
